## COYOTE RUN HOSPITALITY RIDER

We pride ourselves on being a fairly low-maintenance band. We like to show up, do our job professionally and excellently, make everyone happy and leave. However, we have found that promoters vary widely in their understanding of what a band needs and/or wants. Below, please find a list of our needs and then our wants. The needs are required whereas the wants are “wouldn’t it be nice if...”

### Needs:

- 2 double occupancy rooms and 1 room with King bed in Quality Inn type hotel or better within 15 min of the venue. Hotel must provide breakfast.
- Secure, free parking at hotel & venue with easy access for loading. If easy access is impossible, then promoter will provide additional hands to assist with the loading of our gear.
- Refreshments backstage to include:
  - Bottled Water (case)
  - Fresh Coffee (with appropriate condiments)
  - Fresh fruit tray

If the event is a festival, we require food vouchers or meals to be served at reasonable intervals during the day. There should be sufficient food for the 5 members of the band plus our merchandise manager who eats no pork.

If the event is an evening concert, we need dinner to be provided in a manner that allows us time to sound check, eat and get dressed for the show.

A private and secure location for changing clothes and the storing of personal gear.  
Clean restroom facilities.

### Wants:

- We do not require beer or wine backstage, but if promoter would like to provide such, here are our preferences:
- Beer: Assorted micro-brews & Guinness
- Wine: Shiraz or Sauvignon Blanc
